Observation from the Y-[couloir](#) on Black Mountain in the Absarokas (outside of the advisory area) 4/1/22:

"Crown was 4-6" deep, approximately 30' across (just shy of the width of the couloir the length of the couloir). Layer that slid consisted of new, unconsolidated snow. The slide was triggered, skier stayed on his feet as it ran by them. We dug a pit beforehand on a similar aspect and go aspect N. New snow concerns matched that of the forecast for today."
